Durham County Council operates a co-ordinated admission scheme with other admission authorities within Durham County Council's area and with our neighbouring local authorities.

Equal Preference System

All schools in the Durham County Council area operate an equal preference system. Admissions authorities, where appropriate, will consider all first, second and third preference applications together and apply their admission criteria to everyone who applied on time to determine the allocation of places to the school. This means that any places at an oversubscribed school will be offered on the basis of equal preference rank order and where an offer is made it will be for the highest ranked school at which we can offer a place. Where we cannot offer a place at any of the preferred schools, the offer of a place will be made at the nearest school to the parental address that has a place available. Please refer to the parents' guide for further information on the equal preference system.

Admission Policies and Criteria

Voluntary aided (faith) schools, community schools, foundation schools and academies can have different admission policies and criteria that determine how they allocate places. You will need to consider the admission policy for any school or academy you apply for in order to determine what criteria applies to each. Please read the parents' guide carefully as it contains all the information you need about the admission policies.

Address
