

As Scientists we will be investigating the function of parts of flowering plants, requirements of growth, water transportation in plants, life cycles and seed dispersal. We will also be studying living things in their habitats and food chains.

As Computing Technicians we will use coding programs such as Kodu to design and write programs that accomplish specific goals, including controlling and simulation. We will also use databases to collect and organise data.

As Artists we will be learning about and developing our painting knowledge and techniques, through studying and painting Rainforest animals.

As Designers we will be designing and making soups and dips using food items from around the world.

As Geographers we will be studying climate zones, focusing particularly on the Rainforest and climate change. Mapping will also be a focus this term, looking at world maps, tropics and the equator along with international trade.

In RE we will be studying Hindism, looking particularly at 'What do Hindu's believe?'

As Musicians we will be listening to, appraising and performing a range of songs including 'Blackbird' by the Beatles using the Charanga music service.
